£250	Dance with Passion - full day dance workshop	To get children active and enjoying dance. To reach those children who do not enjoy sport. To give all year groups the chance to have fun doing exercise. Teachers feel more confident in delivering dance.
£1914	Sedbergh School - pool hire Swimming coach and life guard	To enable children to continue to improve their swimming. To progress to the next level of the STA Seal award for personal survival, making children more confident swimmers.
£4384	CAM Coaching	This coaching has ensured that all children in the school get high quality PE lessons and Sports coaching. In turn, this has meant that our pupils can perform extremely well at sporting competitions both inside and outside of school. The nature of the competitive sports taught has helped our pupils with self-control and sportsmanship, as well as competitiveness across the curriculum. It also increases their enjoyment of sport.
£295	Skipping Workshop	The whole school participated in a Skipping Day. They enjoyed learning new styles and tricks of skipping. This has encouraged them to skip at break times and at home, which is easily accessible needing low cost equipment.
£1253.74	Safari Sports - gym equipment	To enhance P.E. lessons. Children are using a new, greater range of equipment. Children have access to and are being taught a broader range of gym disciplines. Giving them confidence using gym equipment.
£256	Teacher supply cover	To release our P.E. co-ordinator to accompany children to sporting events. Giving children the opportunity to participate in competitive sports. To build confidence, self-esteem and make them proud of their achievements. Enabling them to pursue sport from a local to county level.
£85.75	Bishop Sports - activity skittles	To enable jumping to be incorporated in P.E. lessons. Children are being taught how to jump. They are also used in multi-gym as another element.
£147.25	Y.P.O.	To purchase skipping pack, balls and playground equipment to enhance break times and P.E. lessons. To link in with the skipping workshop, for children to continue to enjoy and be enthusiastic about skipping. Children are enjoying playing and keeping active. Instilling in them the need for a healthy, active lifestyle.
