<p>PSED: Rules and responsibilities RE – How can we use our hands? Understanding the World: Geography – Look at which countries grow which crops. Maps, globes, atlases. Human and physical features. Science – Science – Growth and Change (Sc2) Identify basic plant parts. Plant investigations – growing cress heads, beans in jars, gardening in school garden. Seasonal change – Spring. ICT – Use programmable toys such as roamer, beebot – to follow routes Expressive Arts and Design: Art – Artist – Henri Matisse (Snail) D&T – Explore different media, materials, textures and objects using hands e.g paint, clay, sand etc Music – Make sounds with hands – clapping, tapping, slapping. Clap or march to rhythms. Composition using instruments that make multiple sounds. PD: PE - team games - relay style games / football (defending and attacking) C&L / Literacy: English - Recounts / Information texts / instructions. T4W: Hungry Caterpillar, Jack and the Beanstalk Maths: Doubling and halving, sharing, addition and subtraction.</p>	<p>PSED: RE – What feelings can we talk about Family and friends / changing and growing Understanding the World: Geography – Human and physical features. Continents and Oceans. Hot and cold areas of the world. Identify places that are near and far. History – Food – look at different packaging and foods we used to eat. Holidays then and now. Physical features. Events beyond living memory. Science – Seasonal change – summer ICT – Use google earth to explore locations for holidays etc. Expressive Arts and Design: Art – Sketch local area / observational drawing / print using roller.
