AUTUMN 2021 – THE ANCIENT GREEK CIVILISATION

Make a travel brochure for Greece. Your aim is to persuade people to visit Greece. Think about the reasons why people choose Greece.



Imagine that you have been whisked back in time to Ancient Greece. You have been allowed to take an object from present day (2021). What would you take and how would you explain your choice?



Temples were important buildings in Greece. Research what they looked like and how they were built, then make your own model.



Make an A-Z of Greece. Think about presenting your work in the best possible way.



Design your own Labyrinth. It could be made of straws, string or wood.



The Ancient Greeks made up stories called myths. Their stories were tales of gods, heroes and mythical creatures. Make up your own Greek myth or listen to an Ancient Greek Myth at bbc.co.uk/teach/schoolradio/history and create a comic strip to retell the story.

Create a picture of an imaginary Greek god. Make sure the picture is eye-catching and full of facts and information. Try to think of a symbol for your god.



Make a word search for words linked to our Ancient Greek topic.

Archimedes, a famous Ancient Greek investigated the science of floating and sinking. Investigate why a large cargo ship can float. Also investigate why a submarine can float and sink. Draw diagrams to help your explanation.



Tokyo Olympic Games have recently been on - what new sporting event would you like added to the Olympic games and why?



Make a Greek plate and decorate with Greek patterns.
