Yew: Betty and Art

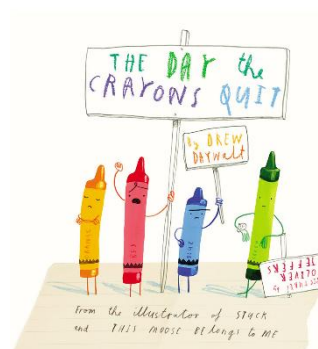
